

On March 29, 2022, at the Kutno City Hall, a meeting was held with a representative of Newly Weds Foods Poland - Mr. Dariusz Świerczyński. The American company, which purchased land in the Kutno Industrial Zone in the fall of last year, will soon begin construction of a food processing plant at Economics Street in Kutno.

The purpose of the meeting, co-organized by the Kutno City Hall at the request of Newly Weds Foods Poland, was to familiarize the guests with the new investor, the planned investment and the schedule of the project. Among the invited guests were representatives of the County Office in Kutno, the County Building Supervision Inspectorate in Kutno, the County Sanitary and Epidemiological Station in Kutno, the County Headquarters of the State Fire Service in Kutno, the Water and Sewage Company in Kutno, and the heads of the neighboring municipalities.

Newly Weds Foods is a world leader in the production of food coatings, seasonings, sauces and functional additives for leading and recognized brands whose products are available both in retail chains and in QSR restaurants. The American company has almost 30 production plants around the world, and its products reach customers in over 90 countries. Employment in all plants exceeds 3,300 people.

The plant in Kutno will be built on a plot of land with an area of 8 ha and will occupy an area of 13 500 m<sup>2</sup>. The planned date of commissioning the factory in Kutno is July 2023. At the beginning of the activity, the employment will amount to over 70 people.
